Personnel Committee Discussion

Motion: Mr. Saunders made a motion, based upon the recommendation of the Personnel Committee, to increase Executive Director Ms. Paczkowski's salary from \$133,250 annually to \$135,000. Mr. Tillett seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.

7. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Revised fee for shared interest QDRO's

Ms. Paczkowski advised the Board that she had received the first Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO) for administration by the Pension Board and recommended a fee reduction be applied to a shared interest QDRO due to the limited time required for the administrative review of this type of QDRO.

Motion: Mr. York made a motion to amend the QDRO Procedure by reducing the fee for a shared interest QDRO to \$500. Mr. Saunders seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.

Estimated costs for military buyback – Exhibit 2

Ms. Paczkowski reviewed with the Board the estimated cost for the military buyback prepared by the Board's actuary, Mr. Alan Pennington. The cost, including the fees charged by the actuary to calculate the buyback, was estimated to be \$907,974.36
